# Airside Operational Notice

### Victor Holding Points EFFECTIVE 18<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2019

Vehicle holding points are being introduced at Hawarden Airport.

The following Vehicle Holding Points will be introduced: V1 to V5

V1 will be located at the existing Runway '04 Factory Side Barriers'

V2 will be located at the existing Runway '04 Tower Side Barriers'

V3 will be located at the existing 'Tower Barriers'

V4 will be located at existing 'Gate 7'

V5 will be located at existing 'Foxtrot'



The Runway crossing point will become a radio controlled crossing where all vehicles will require a positive clearance to cross or enter the Runway. By default the traffic lights be set to red with the barriers down

#### **Use of V3 + V4**

Use of Taxiway Alpha between V3 and V4 will become silent ops. Vehicles are permitted to proceed between V3 and V4 and vice versa subject to a green traffic light being displayed and barriers up.

By default the traffic light will be set to green with barriers up and only set to red with barriers down to protect the Taxiway/Apron for aircraft operations.

#### **Use of V5**

V5 will become the Vehicle Holding Point for vehicles entering / vacating at the Fire Station. All references to Foxtrot shall cease.

Only Runway Driving badge Holders are allowed to use V5
